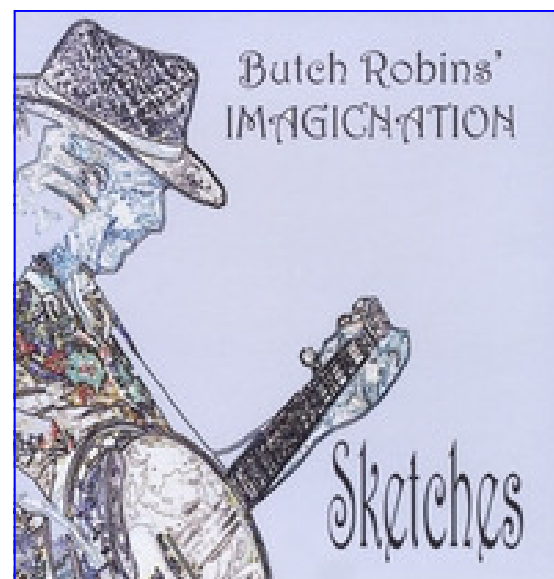

1:00 p.m. Sharing Memories

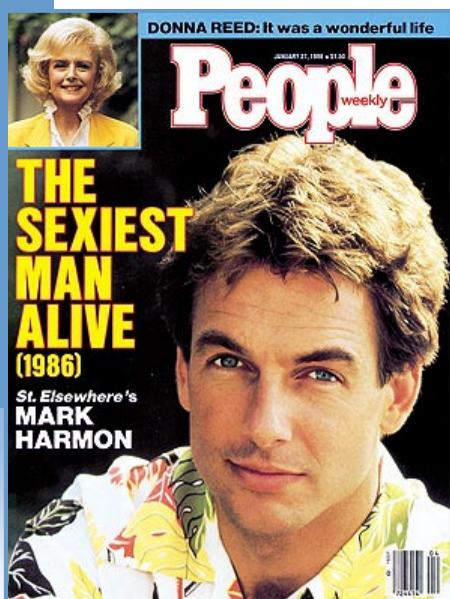
Enjoy pictures and information from the library's past and hear stories from 1986 to the present.
